**Purpose of Meeting:** Discussion of the Prevention/Early Intervention planning process.

**General Discussion on Prevention and Early Intervention:**

David Gray started the meeting by presenting the waterfall diagram (see below) which portrays the continuum of services. He indicated that as we discuss prevention and early intervention programs, we should consider getting folks who have gone over the waterfall back up into the river. To the extent that we can provide PEI programs that target both undiagnosed people as well as provide socialization support to those who have, would be ideal.

**Identification of Assets:**

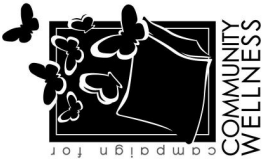
The group began to identify the assets along the continuum (see below). Several successful Evidence-Based Practice programs were mentioned. We agreed to take this exercise to the broader Campaign Steering Committee so that we can have a more complete asset map.

**Day Treatment Program:**

It was advocated that we should reinstitute the Day Treatment Program and provide the appropriate medication and counseling to those about to go over the waterfall. It was suggested that all of the funds available for adults should go to this type of program.

**Latino Programs**

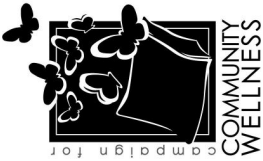
It was presented that there be juntas to deal with: parenting, family dynamics (respect, self-esteem, roles, domestic violence, abuse). Potential school would include: Auburn (Rock Creek, E.V. Cain), Roseville (Adelante), Lincoln (First St., Glen Edwards Middle School, High School). Also it was suggested to have someone at the school inform parents about the day, answer questions, offer information and guidance, help interface with teachers and administration.



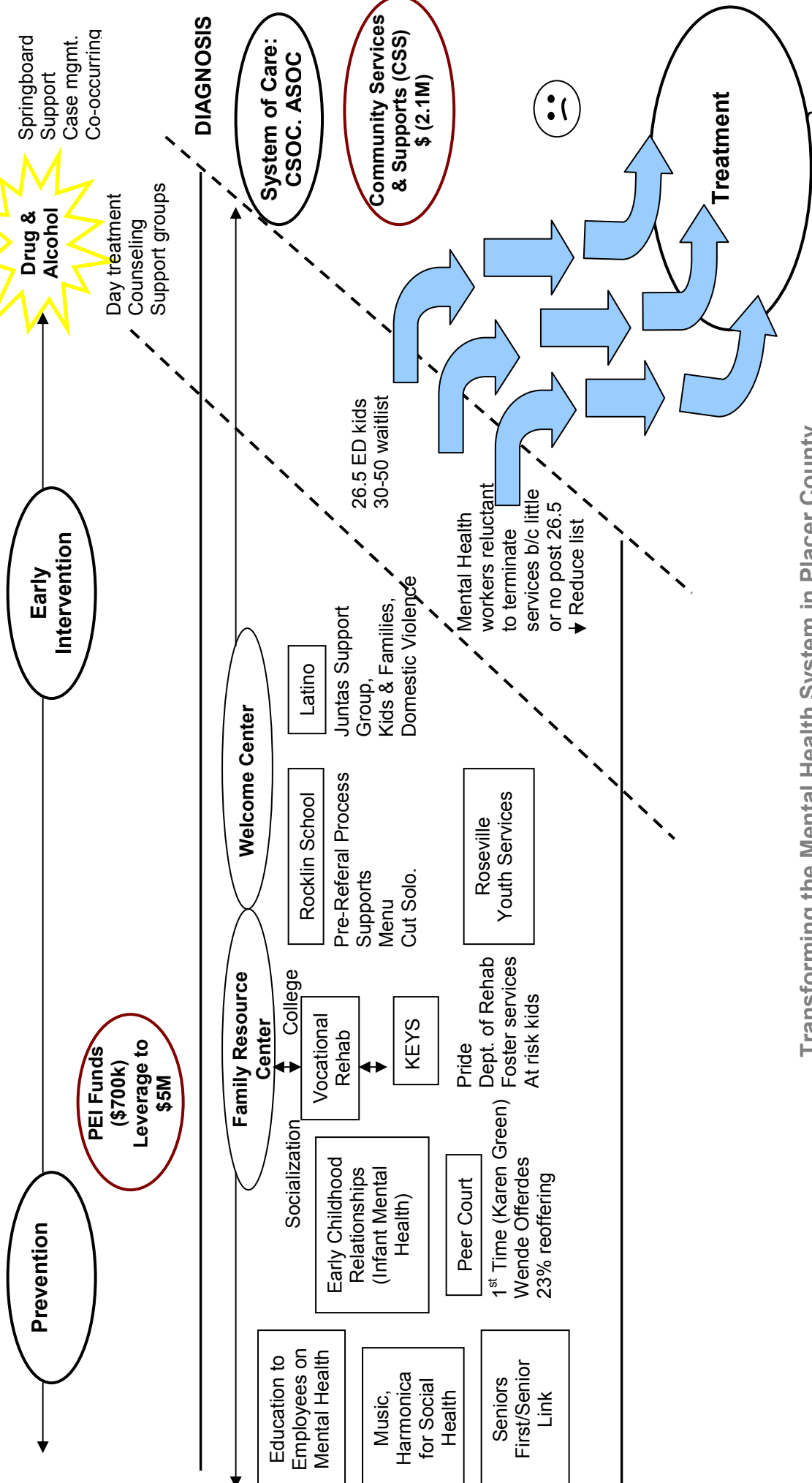
**Data Needs:**
