

## **PEI Workgroup (MHSA Children & Youth) Meeting Notes - January 9, 2008**

### **What Stands Out/Missing**

- Concern – lack of actual community input-more professional
- Professional – not connected to front line
- Increase youth & parent/youth
- Go back to SAM's group for youth voice
- Foster youth
- Input from kids in the hall
- Parent Project Teen Group – Terri Powell
- Mental Illness – Ed in younger kids
- Pregnant teens – children of teens
- Law enforcement ill equipped to deal w/1550, etc. – add to partners
- Add gangs pg. 2 – Latino leadership input
- Lighthouse – Spanish speaking parents group-desires parent project/Spanish
- 26.5 – [3-22] pre-referral activities/preventive activities
- Rocklin Unified SD pre 26.5 – activities; 26.5 referrals dropped, social skills, small group, behavior coaching, “2nd Step” – “we can problem solve” pilot (1 middle and 1 feeder school)
  - 3 key leading to 26.5: depression, isolation, poor social skills
- Autism & Asperger – pre-K-22 district/out-of-home placement
- Need for school-based substance abuse services (SAP)
- Student Services – SAP
- Pre-school kids need (look at First 5 relationship 0-3)
- Look at “upstream” as much as possible

### **Priority Population**

- 0-3 → Brain Development (*what outcomes are trying to achieve?*)
- Adolescent Development (8th) / Brain Development (8-9th)
- Pre-K → 3rd (*some of most effective 3-8 yrs old*)  
*School readiness early interventions*
- Transition Age Youth
- Families Drug/Alcohol/Domestic Violence
- School Success for Latino – *transition from 8-9 grade*

- “Parent Project” research by Roseville PD
- Geography Tahoe: *Pockets of Poverty*
  - Sheridan
  - Foresthill/Michigan Bluff
  - Colfax/Alta

} Rural Isolation  
(law enforcement may be for isolation outreach)
- Demand for Services now vs. long-term
- Domestic violence/Substance Abuse, Drug, Alcohol
